**1994 Cenacle Mass at the
Immaculate Conception
Church, Lowell, MA
October 28, 1994

I don't normally come down to my office this early on a Saturday morning after a late night, but this morning is special. Yesterday afternoon about 4:45 pm a group of people boarded a bus at St. Anthony's Church in Woburn. We were headed for Lowell and The Immaculate Conception Church. A priest from Italy named Father Stefano Gobbi was going to lead a Cenacle Mass. Do you know what a "Cenacle Mass" is? I didn't, so I looked up the word "Cenacle". It wasn't in my Franklin Wordspell, American Heritage Dictionary, Webster's Collegiate Dictionary, but it was in the Webster's New Riverside University Dictionary (\$5.00 Building 19 1/2). Cenacle was listed as "A small dining room usually on an upper floor." I was not impressed

with that definition so, I looked onward. I thumbed through all of my encyclopedias and dictionaries, they seemed centuries old (they are), till finally, in an ancient French and English Dictionary dated 1903, I found the definition I expected. Cenacle, A guest-chamber (where the Lord's Supper was taken).

The Mass was organized by The Marian Movement of Priests. Fr. Stefano Gobbi is the founder and promoter of The Marian Movement of Priests. Rev. Stefano Gobbi was born on March 22, 1930, in Dongo, Italy. He was ordained to the Priesthood in 1964. He holds a doctorate in theology from the Pontifical University of the Lateran in Rome. On May 8, 1972, while praying at the Chapel of the Apparitions at Fatima, the Mother of God impressed upon him, her desire that he start the Marion Movement of Priests.

Reassured by an unmistakable sign that it was God's will, and with the approval of his spiritual director, he and two other priests began the movement on October 13, 1972. The Movement has spread throughout the world. Fr. Gobbi has been receiving

"interior locutions," messages which Fr. Gobbi has been receiving from the Blessed Mother since 1973. Fr. Gobbi is the instrument chosen by Our Lady to carry her voice to the hearts and souls of her beloved children. In it she manifests her maternal plan to lead all souls back to Jesus.

We were all given the opportunity to write petitions and hand them in to the ushers. The program commenced at approximately 7:00 pm. The events began with an Invocation to the Holy Spirit then songs and prayers of the Rosary. Mass was said, (I counted about 30 priests on the altar; all of them distributed Holy Communion). The priests recited an "Act of Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary." The Eucharistic Prayer was read and then we all recited an "Act of Consecration for the Faithful." A selection of hymns was sung and then we sang the International Hymn of The Marian Movement of Priests, "Immaculate Heart of Mary" lyrics written by Fr. Gobbi.

From where I sat in the church, I estimated Fr. Gobbi to be slightly more than 5' 5"

tall, and a little on the heavy side. Fr. Gobbi did the homily of the Mass, his delivery was magnetic (he drew me toward him, as he spoke I threw all my senses in his direction so I wouldn't miss a sound or a gesture, he spoke not just with words but with his hands (I was glued to his body language), and heart (I could feel his love and adoration for The Blessed Mother and me). I could sense how much he loved every one in the church.

He asked for all the babies in the church to be brought to him and he proceeded to hold each child up to the Blessed Mother (a statue of The Blessed Mother led the procession and was placed at the right side of the altar). He then asked all of the pregnant mothers in the church to come to him and he proceeded to bless them and their pre-born babies. I estimate the total number of people in the church to be around 2000 (upstairs and downstairs, the people downstairs watched the Mass on closed circuit TV).

Fr. Gobbi explained to us why he came to America. He said he came because Pope John Paul was too ill to

come. He said he would visit many states and many cities. He said he came to talk to all Americans about the problems in the Church and with the priests. He said some priests in America have decided not to listen to the Pope. He said we should not be disrespectful to these priests, and we should not judge them, but we should pray for them. If you believe a priest is not responding properly to a request, Fr. Gobbi said, "do not do what he tells you."

Fr. Gobbi also observed, "The world has become a society of paganism." We are in love with material things. He said, "The ten commandments are commandments not suggestions." He conveyed to us the message that, Mary and Jesus are close at hand and Satan's days are numbered. The chastisement will happen in the next 5 or 6 years (he said closer to 5). He said if we stayed close to Mary we would be prepared and that we had nothing to fear. He said, "Do not fear" (He said that three times in succession).

I had goose-bumps through the whole evening. I fought

off tears all night. My body went through a series of hot and cold waves, it was like standing on a floor vent and someone continued to turn on the heat then switch to the air conditioner. The heat and cold would alternate and each would start at my feet and continue to fill me up like a glass of liquid, right up to the top of my head. I described that feeling to someone once before, they told me I was being filled with the Holy Spirit. I believe that.

When Fr. Gobbi was leaving the church, by way of the main aisle, I could see in the eyes of the people around him, happiness and love for this wonderful messenger of Mary. I had the urge to touch him, I wanted him to see me, I waved at him as he came up the aisle, people all around me began to wave as well, and at that moment I could imagine being in Rome and waving a white handkerchief at the Pope. It was a feeling like no other I have ever had. It was an emotional experience and I felt like crying because I knew I may never see this man of God again. We got home around 11:00 pm last

night.
I have just finished doing what I set out to do this morning. It's 1:05 pm the next day. I am a different person today; I have experienced somethingglorious

Members of Congress Press for Planned Parenthood Investigation

More members of Congress are pressing for an investigation of the Planned Parenthood abortion business following a new comprehensive report issued by Americans United for Life detailing extensive abuses.

Americans United for Life issued a new report featuring a groundbreaking analysis of the nation's largest abortion business and saying it has uncovered evidence of systemic financial irregularities within the abortion giant, which receives more than \$363 million in federal and state taxpayer funding, and that Congress should investigate.

AUL staff combed through 20 years of Planned Parenthood financial data and the report documents the known and alleged

abuses by Planned Parenthood, including the misuse of federal health care and family planning funds, failure to report criminal child sexual abuse, failure to comply with parental involvement laws, assisting those in engaged in prostitution and/or sex trafficking, and dangerous misuse of the abortion drug RU-486.

Tomorrow, AUL officials will hold a press conference with Rep. Renee Ellmers, a North Carolina Republican, and Rep. Randy Hultgren, an Illinois Republican, who have invited other members of Congress to join them in calling for a congressional probe of the abortion giant.

Congressman Doug Lamborn, a Colorado Republican, rep. Chris Smith, a New Jersey Republican, and Rep. Bill Huizenga, a Michigan republican, will join the event as well.

Catholic Bishop Drops Komen Support Over Planned Parenthood Ties

A Catholic bishop in Ohio says his "misgivings" about the Susan G. Komen for the Cure Foundation over its ties to the Planned Parenthood abortion business make it so

he is suggesting that Catholics not support the organization.

In a letter, Most Reverend Leonard P. Blair, the Bishop of Toledo, Ohio, said numerous questions Catholic have raised about Komen prompted him and his fellow Ohio bishops to investigate and his conclusion is that Komen has Planned parenthood connections and may support embryonic stem cell research.

□ They are open to embryonic stem cell research, and may very well fund such research in the future. They are also contributors to Planned Parenthood, which, though it may claim to provide needed medical services to poor women, is also the largest provider of abortions in our country, Blair writes.

Those ties are sufficient for him to suggest to Catholics that they not participate in Komen events and he said the Catholic Church in Toledo, Ohio will not support Komen.

In order to avoid even the possibility of cooperation in morally unacceptable

activities, the other Bishops and I believe that it would be wise to find alternatives to Komen for Catholic fundraising efforts, □ he writes. □ For that reason, I am directing that in the fight against breast cancer, fundraising carried out under Catholic auspices, including our schools, should be channeled to our locally known Mercy Cancer Centers instead of Komen. □

Blair says Catholics should not back down in supporting women dealing with breast cancer or helping them prevent it, but he said Catholics have a moral obligation to help groups like Mercy that do so without other morally compromising positions.

Sebelius Faces Congressional Hot Seat Over Obamacare Rationing

Health and Human Services Secretary Kathleen Sebelius faced the hot seat this week in two different Congressional hearings about the future of American health care and rationing under Obamacare.

Rep. Paul Ryan, a pro-life Wisconsin Republican, used the occasion to question the abortion advocate about one of the most lethal aspects of the President's plan: Medicare's Independent Payment Advisory Board, or IPAB. Ryan chipped away at the claim that IPAB would protect Medicare and he said there is a better way to solve Medicare's financial crisis without rationing care.

The Independent Patient Advisory Board makes recommendations to Congress, Sebelius said. It is forbidden by law to do exactly what the Republican budget plan does. They may not shift costs to seniors. They may not change benefits.

All final decisions remain in the hands of Congress, Sebelius said in her prepared statement. If Medicare costs are rising at an unsustainable rate, it's Congress's choice whether to accept those recommendations, or come up with recommendations of its own to put Medicare spending on a stable, sustainable path.

But Rep. Joe Pitts, a pro-life Pennsylvania Republican, said there is widespread opposition to IPAB.

This is not surprising, since the decisions of the board will become law by a fast track process that will bypass the usual legislative procedures, in effect superseding

the customary jurisdiction of committees like this one, said Pitts. Rep. Frank Pallone, a Democrat, also voiced his opposition to IPAB, and Rep. Allyson Schwartz, a Pennsylvania Democrat, did as well.

Senate Cmte Votes Thursday on Pro-Abortion Judge Steven Six

The Senate Judiciary Committee will reportedly vote on Thursday on President Barack Obama's latest pro-abortion nomination for a federal judicial position, pro-abortion former Kansas Attorney General Steven Six.

Opposition has built to Six as pro-life groups have ratcheted up the campaign against him due to his ties to the abortion industry and his efforts to delay or stop an investigation into potentially illegal late-term abortions at a Planned Parenthood facility in Kansas, where Six was the state attorney general. The abortion business was accused of making up illegitimate reasons for the abortions and doctoring paperwork to justify them.

Six, in his position as the leading attorney in the state, did everything possible to delay the investigation and tried to have the state Supreme Court deny prosecutors access to the patient files and other evidence they needed to prove their

case.

Kansans for Life which has been leading opposition to Six, has again urged votes against him.

We were appropriately pleased when our two Kansas U.S. Senators (Pat Roberts and Jerry Moran) previously announced their opposition to the nomination of Kansan Steve Six to the U.S. Court of Appeals (one level below the U.S. Supreme Court), □ KFL said today. And we were thrilled the next day when Senate Judiciary Committee chair Patrick Leahy postponed the committee vote. At that time, the White House even called Sen. Moran's office very upset about his decision to oppose Six. Senator Moran stood his ground and said his opposition is firm. □

The pro-life group said Republican lawmakers need to stand strong against Six's nomination.

In anticipation of the UN Conference on Children later this month, International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF) has released a new document,

Exclaim!

In this document, Planned Parenthood leads an all-out assault against parental rights over their children by calling for laws to empower children and leave parents out in the cold.

Some key excerpts from the document:

Inalienable: Everyone is entitled to human rights simply for being human. Human rights cannot be taken away or given up from anyone, irrespective of their age, gender, ethnicity, race, religion, nationality, sexual orientation, socio-economic status, disability, HIV status or health status. reproduction, reproductive health and parenthood.

This from the people aborting over 330,000 humans per year in the US, including those with disabilities. This from the people doing gender-specific abortions. Do they hear themselves speak?

Another reason why young people's sexual rights are particularly complex is because of the need to both

protect and empower young people. There is a common assumption that young people are incapable of making decisions for themselves, so parents or other adults should have full authority over decisions related to their sexuality. Resistance to recognize young people's sexuality and their decision-making abilities makes the realization of young people's sexual rights all the more challenging.

The concept of the evolving capacity of young people stems from the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. It draws attention to the rights of children and adolescents, as well as calls on leaders and societies to value young people's opinions and decisions in light of their evolving capacities.

As a father of three young children, I have not noted in them any evolved capacity for making sound and reliable judgments regarding sex. I'm still trying to get them to make good hygiene a habit. They *need* strong parental authority to guide them in their development.

All people under 18 years should enjoy the full range of human rights, including sexual rights.

The importance and relevance of some rights change as a person transitions from infancy to childhood to adolescence. Therefore, the rights of children and youth must be approached in a progressive and dynamic way.

The rights and protection of young people under the age of 18 differ from those of adults. Particular attention must be given to these differences in relation to sexual rights. The evolving capacity of young people to make decisions about their health and well-being must be recognized, while also ensuring appropriate protection of their best interests.

Were all of that not enough, here's the killer, one of PP's stated goals:

REMOVAL OF PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT OR SPOUSAL CONSENT LAWS THAT PREVENT YOUNG PEOPLE FROM SEEKING SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH SERVICES.

Defining Adolescence

As most societies define adolescence and youth in terms of both age and life circumstances, there is no universal agreement on what is a 'young person'. The national legal age for political participation and the availability of data on different age groups can also determine how societies define youth. The World Health Organization defines young people as those from 10 to 24 years of age, including adolescents (10–19 years) and youth (15–24 years). **IPPF (International Planned Parenthood Federation) uses the terms young people, youth and adolescents interchangeably to refer to people who are between 10 and 24 years.** Defining all people under 18 years of age as a child is often not useful because it ignores the circumstances of youth who are faced with pressures and responsibilities that are usually reserved for adults. Policies and programs for young people should

focus not so much on age, but on the specific developmental needs and rights of individuals as they transition from childhood to adulthood.

This new document, **Exclaim!** does not specify a bottom age limit, though **Stand and Deliver** does. Perhaps **Exclaim!** is going all the way with no age restrictions at all.

Exclaim! is as diabolical a piece of evil as can be crafted. Planned Parenthood has declared an all-out World War on parental rights. If there were doubts before, there can be no doubt now as to their malevolent intent regarding our children. This is war!

Santorum Picks Up Endorsement From Iowa Pro-Life Activist

There are several pro-life candidates in the race for the Republican nomination for president, but longtime Iowa pro-life activist Kim Lehman, the former executive director of Iowa Right to

The Santorum campaign announced her endorsement today and it could help the former Pennsylvania senator gain some traction with social conservative voters in the state where he has been lagging behind in the polls, with support in the low single digits in most polls.

Lehman is a widely respected and well-known conservative leader in Iowa. In addition to serving as Iowa's Republican National Committeewoman, Lehman is the Development Director for the John Paul II Stem Cell Institute, a pro-life bioethics organization. She led Iowa Right to Life for years before that and is making the endorsement of Santorum personally not on behalf of either of the groups.

Baby at 8 Weeks - Consider this Doctor's Testimony Statement by Paul E. Rockwell, M.D.:

"Eleven years ago while giving an anesthetic for a ruptured ectopic pregnancy (at 8 weeks gestation), I was handed what I believe was the smallest living human ever seen.

The embryonic sac was intact and transparent. Within the sac was a tiny human male swimming extremely vigorously in the amniotic fluid, while attached to the wall by the umbilical cord. This tiny human was perfectly developed, with long, tapering fingers, feet and toes. It was almost transparent, as regards the skin, and the delicate arteries and veins were prominent to the ends of the fingers."

Dr. Rockwell continues, "The baby was extremely alive and swam about the sac approximately one time per second, with a natural swimmer's stroke. This tiny human did not look at all like the photos and drawings and models of 'embryos' which I had seen, nor did it look like a few embryos I have been able to observe since then, obviously because this one was alive! When the sac was opened, the tiny human immediately lost his life and took on the appearance of what is accepted as the appearance of an embryo at this stage of life (with blunt extremities etc.)."

The statement by Paul E. Rockwell, M.D., an anesthesiologist, was quoted by Dr. and Mrs. J.C. Willke in their Handbook on Abortion.

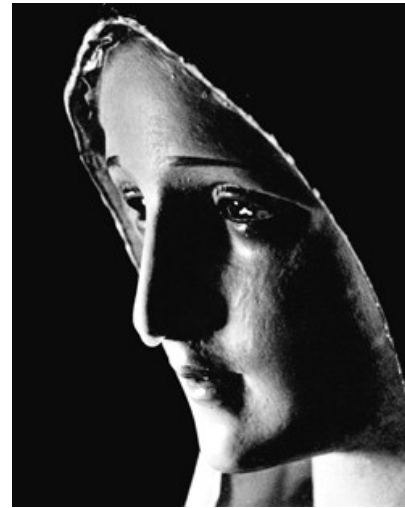
