-- A Barack Obama victory is a setback for pro-life legislative efforts in Washington, but a leader of a national network of crisis pregnancy centers says the pro-life movement can renew its efforts around their direct work to help women in difficult circumstances avoid abortions. In the wake of the presidential election results, Care Net president Melinda Delahoyde says she has good news for pro-life voters. "While legislative efforts to protect the unborn and women from abortion may be limited in future years, the work of pregnancy centers is advancing stronger than ever before," she told LifeNews.com. She says the pregnancy center movement is expanding where it is needed most -- inner cities. That's where abortion figures from state health departments show most abortions are done in most states. "The 'pro-life good news story of the week' is the movement afoot among urban African American church leaders who want to see abortion statistics reversed in their communities and are opening up local pregnancy

centers," Delahoyde explained.

Planned Parenthood's Christmas Wish List for Obama Includes Forced Abortions

- In its first email to supporters following pro-abortion presidential candidate Barack Obama's victory Tuesday night, Planned Parenthood announced its Christmas wish list for an Obama administration. Included in the list is a request for funding for a UN agency involved in forced abortions in China. "People around here are finally exhaling, after eight long years," Planned Parenthood president Cecile Richards told donors in the email. It didn't take long for the head of the nation's biggest abortion business to turn her attention to working with her new White House ally. At the top of Richard's list is sending \$34 million of taxpayer funds per year to an organization that has been involved in the China family planning program that forces couples there to have no more than one child. "It's up to us to take up that challenge and urge Barack Obama to act on his deep commitment to women's health and reproductive freedom by reversing the global gag rule, restoring funding for UNFPA, the United Nations Population Fund," Richards said. The UNFPA has denied any involvement with the China program, which involves forced abortions

and sterilizations for offenders while other violators are thrown in prison, face job loss and family harassment. [Obama would likely restore](#) the funding to the controversial group.

United Nations Expected to Promote Worldwide Abortion Right With Obama

New York, NY (LifeNews.com) --

The United Nations is expected to aggressively promote abortions worldwide with Barack Obama as the new president of the United States. One of the top pro-life lobbyists at the United Nations says he worries the floodgates will come open to perhaps make abortion an international right. Austin Ruse, the president of the Catholic Family and Human Rights Institute, says the UN and abortion advocates there have held off on extensive abortion discussions because they knew the Bush administration would lobby fellow pro-life nations against promoting it. Those reservations will likely be thrown out the window with a new pro-abortion administration's UN liaisons representing that policy. "There was a frenzy of global UN conferences back in the 1990s, including such massive affairs as the Cairo Conference on Population and Development and the Beijing Conference on Women, but during the time of the Bush administration the UN has been relatively quiet," Ruse explains. "The left at the UN counseled quiet during the Bush years for fear of los-

ing ground in the documents that would have come under negotiation," he wrote. "With an Obama administration this fear is removed and one can expect a veritable flood of UN conferences to be announced beginning as early as this year."

Archbishop Chaput to Kmiec: You Wanted Obama, Now Lobby Him on Abortion Washington, DC



(LifeNews.com) -- Catholic apologists for Barack Obama pulled the wool over voters' eyes with their protests that he would have a pro-life administration and would seek to reduce abortions. Now that Obama has been elected, a top Catholic official is urging the Obama backers to make him make

good on his word. During the election, the dueling between Catholic backers and Catholic opponents of Obama reached a fever pitch. Groups like Catholics United and Catholics for the Common Good put up web sites, wrote editorials and sent out millions of mailings to voters to make them think pro-abortion candidate Obama would be pro-life president Obama. Archbishop Charles Chaput of Denver led the charge on the pro-life side against Pepperdine University professor Douglas Kmiec. In a letter to the editor to the web site Public Discourse, Chaput issued told Kmiec he would have to make good on his promises that Obama would reduce abortions and, in a more polite manner, told him to put up or shut up. "Having spent months urging Catholics to vote for Candidate Obama despite the senator's promises to remove all meaningful restrictions on abortion and to make abortion more widely available, Prof. Kmiec has a unique opportunity to press a newly elected President Obama to reconsider his most extreme positions," Chaput wrote in the letter.





Barack Obama Pushes Abortion on Day One With Rahm Emanuel as Chief of Staff Washington, DC



(LifeNews.com) -- Barack Obama didn't wait 24 hours before making his first decision to promote abortion as the President-elect. Obama has offered the White House chief of staff position to pro-abortion Rep. Rahm Emanuel of Illinois, who has a 0 percent pro-life voting record. Emanuel has reportedly officially accepted the position. During the presidential election, pro-life organizations strongly opposed Obama because he supports unlimited abortions any time in pregnancy, backed taxpayer funding of abortion and opposes any limits. In Emanuel, Obama has chosen a clone of himself, accord-

ing to voting records from the National Right to Life Committee. In July 2007, Emanuel voted against an attempt to stop taxpayer-funding of the Planned Parenthood abortion business that brings in over \$1 billion annually by doing 25 percent of the abortions in the United States. As a Congressman, Emanuel has voted against upholding state parental involvement laws allowing parents to know when their daughter is considering an abortion. He voted for making Americans pay for abortions at U.S. military base hospitals, and voted for funding a United Nations agency involved in the forced-abortion one-child family planning policy in China.

Pro-Life Advocates Urged to Renew Efforts Against Abortion After Election Loss Washington, DC (LifeNews.com)

-- Several pro-life leaders are hoping the majority of Americans who take a pro-life position on abortion will re-charge and re-energize following Tuesday night's election defeats. They say the pro-life movement must prepare themselves to take on a pro-abortion president and renew educational efforts. "We have long known that the work of advancing a culture of life is not a short-term project," Americans United for Life president Charmaine Yoest told LifeNews.com. "Recall that William Wilberforce fought against the slave trade for 45 years before he ultimately prevailed in his de-

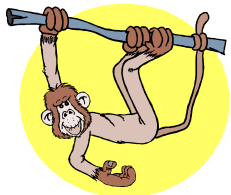

Abortion Advocate Sends Threatening Email to Pro-Life Group Operation Rescue

Uruguay Catholic Leaders Meet to Discuss Excommunicating Pro-Abortion Pols

-- Leaders of the Catholic Church in the South American nation of Uruguay met

on Thursday to discuss whether or not to excommunicate politicians who voted for a recent bill that would legalize abortion. Uruguay President Tabaré Vázquez [vetoed the bill](#) earlier this year and it would have allowed first-trimester abortion on virtually any grounds. Vázquez defied the votes of his party in the Uruguay Congress to expand the nation's abortion law, which currently only allows abortions only in cases of protecting the mother's life, rape or extreme poverty. The Senate initially tied on a 15-15 vote in approving the bill but eventually approved it on an 18-13 vote. The Chamber of Deputies approved it on a 49-48 margin. With many members of the Senate majority having membership in the Catholic Church, officials are concerned that they are violating the church's pro-life teachings. The Latin American news agency Prensa Latina says members of the Uruguayan Episcopal Conference debated a measure for excommunication.

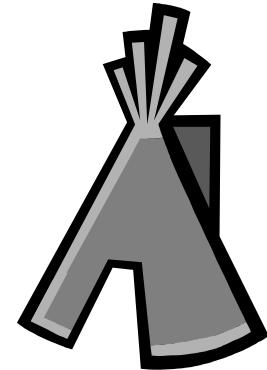
