A. WEATHER, ENEMY AND TERRAIN

All coordinates KD Sheet no. 6342 IXXX
and 6342 IV series L7014 Vietnam.

a. General. Enemy contact during the month of June was light to moderate. The enemy fired approximately 438 rounds of medium and light artillery, rockets and mortars into the Khe Sanh Combat Base. Shelling was harassing in nature.

On 9 June, Foxtrot Company had the mission of convoy security. At coordinates 924404 and 926406 the convoy was ambushed by an unknown size NVA unit. The second security vehicle was focal point of intense small arms fire, followed by satchel charges, grenades and B-40 rockets. NVA were wearing U. S. type helmets, utilities and upper body armor. One platoon was deployed to high ground on left side of road and made additional small arms contact, which resulted in eleven (11) NVA KIA.

On 25 June, the Battalion conducted a three (3) company operation within our AO. There was negative contact.

On 29 June Delta Company, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines OPCON to the Battalion received a probe of approximately 25 to 35 NVA at coordinates 801408. Company engaged the enemy force, resulting in fourteen (14) NVA KIA confirmed.

The following intrusion detection and target acquisition devices were obtained during the month of June. One (1) night operating device (NOD). Also, two (2) PPS-6 radar sets were sent to Regiment for repair.

c. Order of Battle. During the month of June, elements of the 304th and 308th NVA Division had been operating in the Scotland II Area of Operation. Units operating near our AO during the month of June are believed to be located at:

- (1) 57th Infantry Regiment, 304th Division located 900380.
- (2) 9th Infantry Regiment, 304th Division located at 930320.
- (3) 1stBn, 88th Infantry Regiment, 308th Division located at 860360.
- (4) 102nd Infantry Regiment 308th Division located at 830340.

d. Weather and Terrain

(1) Weather. During the month of June there was little rainfall. Trafficability remained good and friendly operations were not effected by weather. Fog has been heavy during the early morning hours, and usually visibility is good by day break.

(2) Terrain. Vegetation is relatively light around the Khe Sanh Combat Base.

3. ORGANIZATION AND OPERATIONS

a. The Battalion was tasked with the defense of Khe Sanh Combat Base for the entire reporting period as well as providing forces for road sweep and convoy security, Bald Eagle and Sparrow Hawk reaction forces, and administrative and support functions for Task Force Hotel and the combat base. On two occasions units were chopped to the Battalion for augmentation in the defense of the combat base and combat outposts in the vicinity.

b. Offensive operations consisted largely of extensive small unit day and night patrols and ambushes. One three-company recon in force was conducted with negative enemy contact.

c. Contact was generally light and consisted primarily of incoming artillery, rockets and mortars on fixed positions and units maneuvering in the field. Significant contact with enemy ground forces developed on two occasions. Incoming at Khe Sanh Combat Base continued from very light to moderate, varying daily from a low of 0 to a high of 95 rounds. Incoming increased significantly during the last week of the month, when the phase-out of the combat base became obvious.

4. AIR SUPPORT

a. Helicopters of the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing in support of the 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines lifted 12 emergency medevacs for a total of 7 sorties. In addition, there were 24 USMC WLA and 1 USN WLA priority medevacs for a total of 16 sorties. Six routine medevac sorties were flown with 8 USMC ELL and 4 USMC WLA.

b. Eleven visual reconnaissance flights were made during the month carrying unit commanders and staff personnel over planned operating areas. Twenty-three preplanned missions were called in for air observers. In addition, extensive use was made by unit commanders in the field of available air observers.

c. There were a total of sixty-seven close air support sorties flown in June. Nineteen of these strikes were controlled by airborne observers forward air controllers. The remaining forty-eight sorties were flown under the control of the TPQ-10 radar.

d. There were four company and battalion size troop lifts, one platoon size lift and one helicopter assault made during the month. Those six missions resulted in a total of sixty-three sorties.

5. ARTILLERY AND FIRE SUPPORT

a. From 1 June to 30 June 1968, fire support liaison was effected by the personnel of Battery "B", 1st Battalion, 11th Marines. During this period those personnel did not suffer any casualties.

b. Four new enlisted men and one new officer reported aboard during the month of June. The present strength stands at 3 officers and 13 enlisted.

c. The 1st Battalion, 11th Marines remained in support the whole month. During the month 23,370 rounds were fired in support and H&I program. The H&I program was supplemented by 81mm mortars.

6. TRAINING

a. During June 1968 training consisted of orientation and FAM firing for new troops, formal school training and company/platoon level classes on weapons safety procedures.

b. New replacements received orientation instructions on customs and traditions of Vietnamese people, land mines and booby traps, scouting and patrolling also an improved instruction period on weapons safety. Although no rifle range was available, all new personnel fired individual weapons for familiarization and zeroing at short distance.

7. LOGISTICS AND SUPPLY

a. Logistics. All classes of supply were adequate to meet the Battalion's needs during June. Difficulty was experienced in obtaining repair parts for most of the Battalion's organic weapons.

b. Supply

c. Motor Transport

(1) Second echelon repair parts for the mule (M27442) continued to be in short supply.

(2) A shortage of trained OP 3500 personnel continued into June.

(3) The new vehicles (M-15141) arrived early in the month and have been placed into operation.

d. Roads. Access roads and MSR's remained passable during the month.

e. Fiscal Obligations. Obligations during June for SF4 items were \$62,910.77.

f. Equipment Repairs. During June 164 Tactical Equipment Orders were submitted to FLSG-4, of those, 122 were completed.

g. Miscellaneous. The Battalion completed the change over of old M-16 rifles to the new chrome-chambered rifles. The contact team that arrived from FLSG-B to assist in the repair of weapons was unsatisfactory and a letter was forwarded to Regiment indicating unsatisfactory trends.

8. CIVIC ACTION/CIVIL AFFAIRS

On 12 June 1968, this Battalion was assigned civic action responsibility for Thay Phu Village, by Task Force X-Ray. Since then civic action has been centered around the construction of a medical ward at that village and the construction of a dam at Phu Bai VI.

9. COMMUNICATIONS

a. During the month of June 1968 the Communications Platoon continued to operate and maintain normal wire and radio communication at Kho Sanh Combat Base, and provided radio communications for convoys to LZ Stud.

b. A high of twenty-seven deadlined AN/PRC 25 radios was reached during the month. This figure was reduced to fifteen, on priority O2 redball requisition, by the close of the month.

c. Helicopter borne couriers, which are required to transport electronic items to third echelon maintenance facility, continue to be a drain on manpower.

d. It is of interest to note that eighteen miles of wire was dispensed in five days servicing existing wire lines, incident to the destruction of Kho Sanh Combat Base.

e. Personnel losses to hostile fire were two WIA's.

10. MEDICAL

a. This Battalion Aid Station treated 319 sick call patients during the month of June. There were 16 USMC KIA's, and 29 USMC WIA's and 1 USN WIA.

b. There were 41 cases of diarrhea, 13 dental cases, 21 FOU, 1 URI, 29 Gastro Intoxicous, 1 dog bite, 27 rat bites, 2 heat exhaustion, 2 cases venereal disease, and 198 nonbattle injuries.

11. CHAPLAIN

a. Protestant Services Held. There were 15 Protestant Services held during the month of June with a total attendance of 207.

b. Catholic Services Held. There were 12 Catholic Services held during the month of June with a total attendance of 136.

c. LDS Quarterly Meeting. Five of the men from 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines attended the LDS Quarterly Meeting during June.

d. Red Cross Messages. Five Red Cross messages were delivered by the Chaplain during the month of June.

e. R&R. The Chaplain returned from R&R on 2 June 1968.

12. PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS

During the month the psychological operations of this Battalion were limited.

Health leaflets pertaining to brushing teeth, washing and disposing of human waste and refuse were distributed in coordination with Mod-Caps at Thuy Phu Village.

Two signs pertaining to brushing teeth and washing were put up in the market place at Thuy Phu Village.

PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTINGS OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. ORGANIZATION AND OPERATIONS

- 1-13 Jun 68 - Golf Company, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines was placed under the operational control of the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines on 1 June at 1500H. This unit remained under 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines control until 131300H.
- 4 June 68 - Golf 2 platoon patrol, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines, became misdirected while proceeding on its return route to Hill 861 (XD803443). In the vicinity of XD806447 the patrol was told to halt by the actual who had spotted them from his position on the hill. The patrol leader advised the actual that he was trying to find a hole in the wire. At this time one of the members of the patrol detonated an M-16 mine, killing two men and wounding four. Golf 1, Golf 2 and Golf 6 Actuals immediately made their way to the mine field and began clearing a path to the patrol. As the casualties were being moved into an LZ for evacuation a second M-16 mine detonated causing a third mine to detonate resulting in eight more casualties. Medevac procedures were finally completed with a total of 2 USMC KIA's and 12 USMC WIA's.
- 7 Jun 68 - Foxtrot 2 Sparrow Hawk was alerted and dispatched to recover bodies from a downed Huey helicopter which apparently struck the top of a ridge and crashed in the vicinity of XD909365. The Sparrow Hawk was lifted into the crash area and proceeded to the site of the wreckage. Three bodies, burned beyond recognition, were found in the wreckage, which was completely consumed by fire. An exhaustive search of the area failed to reveal any of the weapons or radio equipment, assumed to have been destroyed in the fire, although a frequency chart was found which was turned into the S-2. Returned to Khe Sanh Combat Base with the remains.
- 9 Jun 68 - 1st Marines Logistical Convoy, with Company Foxtrot providing security was taken under fire in the vicinity of XD924404 and XD926404 by an unknown size NVA unit. Fire, consisting of intense small arms fire followed by satchel charges, grenades and B-40 rockets, was taken from both sides of the road and was concentrated on the second security truck. One platoon was deployed to high ground on left side of road and conducted a thorough sweep of area making additional light contact. After a thorough

search of the area was conducted all dead and wounded were placed on a vehicle. The convoy was then turned around and returned to Khe Sanh Combat Base. Medevacs were delivered to both LZ Ziegler and Khe Sanh Combat Base for evacuation. This contact resulted in one truck and one night-vision being destroyed. Casualties consisted of 8 friendly KIA's, 9 friendly WIA's and 11 enemy KIA.

24 Jun 68 -At 0800H Company Delta, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines and Company Kilo, 3rd Battalion, 4th Marines were placed under the operational control of 2nd Battalion, 1st Marines, being positioned on Hill 689 and 471 respectively.

25 Jun 68 -Conducted three-company recon in force operation in the area 4000 meters south of Khe Sanh Combat Base as per Texas Pete Frag Order 6-68. Sweep routes of Company Hotel and Kilo 3/4 were thoroughly searched with negative results. The destroyed bunker complexes at Objective B and C showed no signs of reconstruction or occupancy. Sandal tracks were found in the Objective B area but their age could not be determined. Recon in force was completed at approximately 1500H, units returned to permanent operation areas.

29 Jun 68 -At 0430H Company Delta, 1st Battalion, 1st Marines heard movement around perimeter. Upon investigating the area, it was discovered that the enemy had penetrated through the wire. Enemy assault was countered with small arms fire, 81mm mortars and 60mm mortars. After contact was broken a sweep of the position indicated that all enemy had been expelled from the perimeter. Estimated strength of the enemy probe to be 25 to 30 NVA. Following enemy weapons and equipment were captured: nine AK-47's, two SKS, one light machine gun, one B-40 rocket launcher, forty-two chicon grenades, two satchel charges, one mine, one demo kit, one blasting machine, approximately 750 rounds small arms ammo and one medical kit. Casualties resulting from this contact were 3 USMC WIA's 3 USMC WIA's, and 14 enemy KIA's.

2. Logistics and Supply

4 Jun 68 - Contact team from FLSG-B arrived at Khe Sanh to assist in the repair of weapons.

19 Jun 68 - Began to make preparations to move the Battalion from Khe Sanh.

22 Jun 68 - First trucks loaded with the Battalions Retrograde equipment departed Khe Sanh for Ca Lu.

28 Jun 68 - Lt J. D. BURRILL relieved by 1stLt LEENERTS, F. R. as the S-4.
