Kagan Files From Clinton Administration Show Her Backing Human Cloning-Washington, DC

(LifeNews.com) -- Add human cloning to abortion and assisted suicide as practices pro-life groups oppose but Supreme Court nominee Elena Kagan supports. Files released from the Clinton library about Kagan's time in the Clinton administration show her advocating cloning humans for dubious research.

Kagan served as a top domestic policy advisor for ex-President Bill Clinton from 1997-1999 and she played a key role in shaping and executing his response to new cloning technologies.

"Memoranda and emails



leased by the William J. Clinton Presidential Library on Friday document Kagan's involvement in crafting an anti-life position and legislative proposal," says Americans United for Life, whose attorneys investigated them.

A May 29, 1997 memo from Kagan to Clinton and Jack Gibbons, the Assistant to the President for Science and Technology, had Kagan suggesting that Clinton support banning only the kind of human cloning that results in the birth of a live baby.

She urged "that [the President] support domestic legislation banning human cloning" but added Clinton should "support the gist of France's proposed cloning paragraph [in the G-8 Communiqué]."

That proposal would have had Clinton supporting a

clone and kill policy whereby he would have advocated for the cloning of human beings for the sole purpose of killing them in research.

"As the memo explains, Kagan's 'ban' on cloning only banned the use of cloning aimed at the livebirth of a baby, not at cloning that takes human life," AUL notes.

Pro-Life Women Win Big in Tuesday Primary Elections in California, Nevada Washington, DC (LifeNews.com) -- Tuesday's primary elections saw the political landscape in a few states move in the direction of pro-life women and one pro-life organization is delighted by the results. With Carly Fiorina's Senate victory in California and Sharron Angle's in Nevada, pro-life women are now on center stage.

Former Hewlett-Packard CEO Carly Fiorina will face Sen. Barbara Boxer, the leader of the pro-abortion forces in the Senate, this November. Fiorina cruised to an easy victory in the race for the Republican nomination defeating pro-abortion former Rep. Tom Campbell and pro-life state Assemblyman Chuck DeVore. She took home 54 percent compared with 26 percent for Campbell and 19 percent for DeVore.

Marjorie Dannenfelser, the president of the pro-life group Susan B. Anthony List, said in a statement that "Carly Fiorina is helping to usher in the year of the pro-life woman."



She added, "With the victories of pro-life leaders Carly Fiorina in California and Sharron Angle of Nevada, the

void of a pro-life woman's voice in the Senate could finally be filled this November."

"We have worked tirelessly on her behalf to reach voters who are hungry for a strong, pro-life alternative to Barbara Boxer. In choosing Carly Fiorina, California voters have endorsed an authentic feminist and set the stage for a battle of opposites in November," the pro-life women's leader added.

State Assemblywoman Sharron Angle earned the right to face pro-abortion Senate Majority Leader Harry Reid this November.

Angle led the race with 60 percent of the votes compared with 39 percent compared with 28 percent for former Republican Party Chairwoman Sue Lowden and businessman Danny Tarkanian receiving 23 percent.

Activist: Forcing Military Base Hospitals to Do Abortions Just a "Sign of the Times"

Washington, DC (LifeNews.com) -- A massive debate over whether to turn the approximately 250 taxpayer-funded military base hospitals into abortion centers is heating up in the Senate. But, the move to overturn the ban on abortions at the hospitals is nothing out of the ordinary for the president of Cecile Richards.

The president of Planned Parenthood calls turning the military into an abortion business like her own just another "sign of the times" in a Politico interview.

"It's the recognition that reproductive health care for women is basic health care. The world has changed, and women play a larger role in the military. These are all very positive steps," Richards says.

The first step was when the Obama administration, in February, issued a new order for the U.S. military requiring all military hospitals and health centers to stock the morning after pill.

Now, pro-abortion Sen. Roland Burris is taking the next step. <u>He attached an</u> <u>amendment</u> to a bill in the Senate Armed Services Committee that received a 15-12 vote -- with all Democrats supporting it except for Sen. Ben Nelson of Nebraska, who joined all of the committee's Republicans in opposition. "In the Senate, things are good," said Richards. "The good thing is, this amendment puts the issue squarely on the table."

Charmaine Yoest, president of Americans United for Life, told Politico that foisting abortion on the military is just the next step in the pro-abortion agenda.

"They're using the military as a wedge and a way to implement their agenda," she said. "I see them being very craven in looking to use the military to put the stamp of approval of federal government on abortion."

Report Shows Planned Parenthood Abortion Biz Got \$650 Million in Taxpayer Funds

(LifeNews.com) -- A new **Government Accountabil**ity Office report shows the **Planned Parenthood abor**tion business reported spending over \$650 million in federal funds over a seven year period. That averages to just under \$100 million in federal funds each year and is something pro-life groups and lawmakers on Capitol Hill want to see ended. The new 33-page report concerns how much federal money the Planned **Parenthood Federation of** America is receiving and from what sources -- with most of the funds coming from the Title X family planning program. Combining the money received from the Health and Human Services department and USAID, the **GAO** report indicates Planned Parenthood received \$657.1 million in federal funds. The report also shows the pro-abortion group Population Council, which sponsored the dangerous abortion drug RU 486, received \$284.3 million in federal funds as well for its international family

planning efforts. And the Guttmacher Institute, a pro-abortion group that does research on abortion statistics, received \$12.7 million.

Advocates for Youth, another pro-abortion group, received \$8.7 million from the federal government and the International Planned Parenthood Federation received \$3.9 million.

Combined, the proabortion organizations received more than \$1 billion in taxpayer dollars from the federal government over the 2002-2009 period GAO analyzed. Although the money does not directly pay for abortions, which is stopped in most part by the Hyde amendment, the report makes it clear that federal funds are propping up the abortion industry.



Pro -Life Groups Step Up Opposition to Disclose Act Limiting Free Speech

(LifeNews.com) -- Top prolife organizations are stepping up their efforts to oppose the DISCLOSE Act, a bill they say would place unfair limits on the free speech rights of pro-life groups and others when it comes to public legislative and election communications.

The House of Representatives may vote as soon as Thursday on the bill that the National Right to Life Committee says would place "sweeping new restrictions on the ability of" citizens groups to tell the public how their lawmakers voted.

In a letter yesterday to members of the House, NRLC reiterated its strong opposition to the bill, which it called

"pernicious, unprincipled, and unconstitutional legislation."

The House Democratic leadership has agreed to add a narrow "carve out" that will effectively exempt the National Rifle Association from some of the key restrictions in the bill, in return for which the NRA has agreed that it "will not be involved in final consid-

eration of the House bill." But that has drawn objections from the pro-life group, which says, "With respect to the National **Right to Life Committee,** this amendment is not only worthless, but adds insult to injury" and calls the bill "a blatant political attack on the First Amendment rights of NRLC, our state affiliates, and our members and donors." The big problem for prolife groups is a provision that would make them identify donors publicly anytime it runs communications in certain times that ask people to contact **Congress about legislation** related to pro-life concerns.

"Our members and supporters have a right to support our public advocacy about important and controversial issues without having their identifying information posted on the Internet, exposing them to harassment or retribution by those who may disagree with their beliefs," NRLC savs.Louisiana **House Unanimously Sends Pro-Life Ultrasound Bill to Governor Jindal Baton Rouge, LA**

(LifeNews.com) -- The Louisiana state House unanimously approved an ultrasound bill today that will help women get a view of their unborn child before deciding to have an abortion. The state Senate has already passed the measure, which now heads to pro-life Governor Bobby Jindal and will be signed into law shortly.

The measure would give women something abortion centers don't normally provide: a chance to see an ultrasound of their unborn child before the abortion. When used in pregnancy centers, women considering an abortion who see the ultrasound change their mind about the abortion about 80 percent of the time. The House voted 79-0 for Senate Bill 528 sponsored by pro-life Democratic Sen. **Sharon Broome of Baton** Rouge. "This is a bill that empowers women," Broome said in committee. The measure originally required anyone seeking an abortion to listen to a detailed description of the ultrasound of the unborn baby and to receive a photograph of the ultrasound but those requirements were changed in the committee process to make them optional and giving women a chance to sign a document saying they were offered the chance to view the ultrasound.
