# San Diego Reunion Schedule of Events 2023



Reunion (check-in) will start on November 8th and run until (check-out) November 13th

The Annual Reunion is being held this year in San Diego, California. The Dana resort hotel located on Mission Bay will serve as our Headquarters for the reunion. It is a super property, and the amenities are great.

The cost of the hotel this year is \$199 (plus tax) per day. This price includes two coupons per day for a free breakfast buffet with a dedicated omelet chef. The resort fee of \$32 per day has been waived for us along with any parking fee (usually \$30 per day).

Our excursion this year will be on November 9th combining a visit to Mount Soledad National Veterans Memorial in La Jolla followed by a visit to Camp Horno, home of the 1st Marine Regiment.

At Mount Soledad, we will dedicate a plaque commemorating the Vietnam service of the Veterans of the 2d Battalion First Marines. The plaque looks great. It is composed of similar material used on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial wall in Washington, DC and is located at one of the best viewing spots at the Mount Soledad Memorial. The view from the memorial site is fantastic with a panorama of San Diego and the Bay.

#### San Diego Reunion 2023 Schedule of Events Continued

Following the dedication at Mt. Soledad, we will travel to Camp Horno for lunch at the 1st Marines chow hall. After lunch we will conduct a plaque dedication at the 1st Marines Memorial Garden. The plaque dedication honors the 2/1 Marines and attached personnel (Two women Marines and an Army staff sergeant) who were KIA by terrorists at the Kabul airport during a humanitarian evacuation mission.

Following the dedication, and a side trip to the 1st Marines PX for those who are interested, we will travel back to The Dana. The inclusive cost of the motor coach travel and lunch at the 1st Marines chow hall will be \$16 per person.

Access to Camp Horno has restrictions that we must follow. In advance of the excursion, we will need to have the names for each participant by October 15, 2023. Once we have a complete list of excursion attendees Tim Dunn will contact you to get any further pertinent information required to gain access to the base.

Friday, November 10th, we will host our 2nd Annual Ladies Luncheon. It will be held this year at The Dana. The association is subsidizing most of the lunch cost with a charge of \$15 per person for those attending.

Also, on Friday evening, we will celebrate the Marine Corps 248th birthday in the hospitality room with the cutting of a birthday cake and the singing of the Marine Corps Hymn.

Saturday will be a free day for y'all to go and do whatever you want. The hotel has two swimming pools which are heated to 82 degrees for those wishing to just relax by the pool. The restaurant on the premises has a great menu.

This year's banquet meal on Sunday, November 12, will be a buffet style meal. It will include a choice of summer greens or Caesar salad, and entrées of Pork Loin, Lasagna, and Penne Primavera with potatoes and a vegetable medley and rolls, butter, coffee & water. Dessert will consist of our delicious birthday cake.

# ENGRAVED MEMORIAL BRICKS

A double row of Engraved Memorial Bricks line the pathways of the Semper Fidelis Memorial Park, National Museum of the Marine Corps, Quantico, VA. Additionally, approximately 450 bricks were placed around our monument and are available for engraving. To date 176 of these had been sold. Each engraved brick honors the donor or another person. Each brick costs \$300 and you may order as many as you like.

Vietnam Veterans of 2d Bn. 1st Marines will continue to sell bricks as long as there is space to place them at our monument. The museum installs bricks several times a year. We will submit brick orders to the museum in groups to coincide with their ordering and installation pattern.
